Thank you for considering membership in the Rotary Club of Sturgeon Bay. We look forward to your joining us as we serve our club, our community, and our world.

As with any organization, membership in our Rotary Club carries with it certain expectations and obligations. Here is a brief overview; detailed information will be provided at your orientation following your induction into the club.

Attendance:

Rotary International policy is that members shall attend at least 50% of the meetings of their club in each six month period. Various make-up opportunities, such as attendance at committee meetings or involvement in a club activity, allow most of our members to easily meet that standard.

Involvement:

We encourage every member to join one or more of our 30 committees, for it is in our committees that the work of our club is primarily accomplished. You will be provided information on committee activities at your orientation following joining.

Financial:

Club dues are \$187.00 per quarter, pro-rated for the quarter in which you join. The cost of your weekly luncheon at the Yacht Club is included in your dues. Dues are billed quarterly, via email, and are due upon receipt of the invoice.

Special social events, such as our Holiday Party, have an additional charge.

Leaves of Absence, which remove the meal cost from your dues, are available for expected absences of three months or longer. Some short term limited financial assistance is available in special circumstances.

Fund Raising:

Our club carries out two major fundraisers each year.

- On the night of the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship Game we gather at a local venue to cheer on our favorite team and participate in a variety of fun (and fund raising) activities. Admission tickets, which also serve as raffle tickets, are sold by club members in advance.
- Additionally, on the first Saturday in May we conduct tours at our local shipyards. This activity typically involves hundreds of visitors and requires a large number of volunteers.
